Racing Queensland (**RQ**) has received notice from Greyhounds Australasia (**RA**) that it is seeking to make an urgent change to the definition of ‘approved DNA laboratory’ within GAR 9 of the Greyhounds Australasia Rules (GAR).

The proposal, which seeks to include the Racing Australia Equine Genetics Research Centre as an approved DNA laboratory, is set out below:

**approved DNA laboratory** means a laboratory that is approved by *Greyhounds Australasia* for the purpose of *DNA fingerprint analysis*. As at the date of commencement of *these Rules*, the following are *approved DNA laboratories*:

Massey University (**Infogene**), Auckland, New Zealand

Orivet, Melbourne

**Racing Australia Equine Genetics Research Centre, Scone, NSW**
